Benefits to National Security

- Delivers advanced capabilities to the warfighter faster
- Ensures the military is using the latest technology
- Positions the national leadership to respond quickly and flexibly to changes in the international security environment



Benefits to DoD

- Fosters a more integrated, team-based approach to acquisition planning
- Facilitates a more realistic, rational approach to developing and producing new systems
- Checks unconstrained requirements generation – cost and schedule balanced with performance
- Enhances user understanding of system capabilities and alternative concepts of operations
- Encourages more thorough scanning of alternatives, including NDI and commercial
- Promises less expensive acquisition programs and processes, freeing up money for new capabilities
