Traditional Programs

- In traditional programs, collaboration is serial for the most part, and minimal
 - Each stakeholder community works within it's own boundaries until it passes the ball off to the next set of stakeholders
 - Example: once the requirements are done, the requirement developers place their focus elsewhere with little to add to the process

Collaboration takes on new meaning in EA/SD environment

- In EA/SD programs, collaboration is more dynamic
 - Shorter increments necessitate that the stakeholders go back to each other again and again to ensure the overall objectives are being met
 - Tempo of the development process becomes more dynamic

Stakeholder Teamwork Is Essential

- **Must come from the top**
- **Must stay the course**
- **Early and continual user involvement - CRITICAL**
- **The definition of the end target must be understood**
- **Changes must be timely and focused**
- **Common expectations – KEY!!!**
- **Expedite results to the field**
