Washington, D.C. – The Executive Director of the NextGen Institute, in cooperation with the Joint Planning and Development Office (JPDO), announces the selection of Innovative Solutions, Inc. (ISI) to conduct Phase II of the Optimizing Aircraft Sequencing and Spacing in the Terminal Area Task.

The selection was made in accordance with the single-source selection processes as called for in the Other Transaction Agreement (OTA), as reviewed and approved by the Contract Award Oversight Board (CAOB).

ISI, the Phase I awardee, is performing very well in Phase I and is ideally positioned to succeed at the tasking anticipated in Phase II. ISI has established industry contacts that have led to pledges of cooperation with ISI for the flight testing and related data collection. This non-competitive award will enable operational issues to be addressed expeditiously and will allow future benefits to be captured in a timely manner.
